

2017 Pacific Southwest BOMA Emerging Young Leaders Scholarship

Qualifications:

- 1.) Applicant must have less than 5 years experience in the commercial real estate industry (property management or service provider).
- 2.) Applicant must be a member involved in the Owner/Manager BOMA business functions as defined within their local BOMA.
- 3.) Applicant's Owner/Manager BOMA membership must be within the Pacific Southwest Region (PSW), defined as a BOMA located in Arizona, California, Hawaii or Nevada.
- 4.) Applicant must be in good standing with BOMA local, PSW Region and BOMA International.
- 5.) Applicant must be in agreement with the conditions of acceptance stated below.

Conditions of Acceptance:

- 1.) The recipient must attend the full Conference (6/24 – 6/27), participate in one of the Education Tracks made available and attend the PSW Regional meeting.
- 2.) The scholarship scope includes reimbursement up to \$2,500 for 2017 full conference registration, up to three nights of hotel and travel (to and from the conference location) to facilitate attendance at the 2017 BOMA International Annual Every Building Conference & Expo.
- 3.) Within 30 days of conference completion, submit a report to the Pacific Southwest Scholarship Committee recapping the Conference Experience as a whole and particular benefit(s) realized.
- 4.) Reimbursement of applicable conference expenses will require copies of all receipts. Coach airfare will be eligible for reimbursement at the time of purchase. All remaining expenses will be eligible for reimbursement after the required report has been submitted. Expense reimbursement is required to be submitted within 45 days of the conference completion.

Application Requirements:

- 1.) Provide a resume with the following details: Personal, professional and educational Information, current contact information, academic achievements, BOMA and community participation.
- 2.) Letter of recommendation and support from your current employer. Employer must support the Conditions of Acceptance noted above.
- 3.) A letter of recommendation from two of the following:
 - a. PSW BOMA Member in good standing
 - b. PSW BOMA Local Board of Directors Member
 - c. Community Leader, Professor or the equivalent
- 4.) Brief personal letter describing financial need, why you desire the scholarship, and how you will meet the conditions of the scholarship acceptance.

Process & Timeline:

- 1.) Completed resume and all required material must be submitted to the BOMA PSW President, (Mr. David Mastro, Cushman & Wakefield, Inc., 1415 N. Market Blvd. Suite 1, Sacramento, CA 95834) or email a pdf version to david.mastro@cushwake.com.
- 2.) Submission period is between Monday, February 6, 2017 and Monday, March 6, 2017. No applications will be accepted after 5:00pm Pacific Standard Time on Monday, March 6, 2017
- 3.) The Recipient will be announced throughout the Pacific Southwest BOMA Region, as well as at the Awardee's local BOMA chapter no later than Monday, April 3, 2017. (EB Registration ends 5/1/17)
